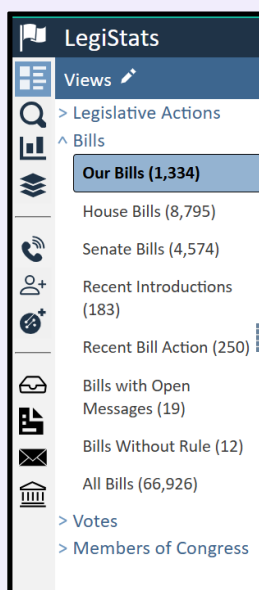


Reviewing Bill Information

Market: House, Senate

Description: These instructions teach users how to search and view bills introduced into either or both chambers of congress.

1. Navigate to **LegiStats** → **Views** → **Bills**.
2. Use the following views to review bill information:
 - a. **Our Bills:** bills specific to an office.
 - b. **House Bills:** bills specific to the US House of Representatives.
 - c. **Senate Bills:** bills specific to the US Senate.
 - d. **Recent Introductions:** bills introduced within the last week.
 - e. **Recent Bill Action:** status of bills that were changed within the last week.
 - f. **Bills with Open Messages:** bills that have associated message records that include the bill number.
 - g. **All Bills:** bills for both House and Senate.



3. Click the **Bill Number** to be taken to the Bill on Congress.gov
